Easy Runner table runner pattern

Show off your favorite fabrics in one
simple-to-make table runner that
stitches up so fast, you'll be making
one for everyone you know!



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EASY RUNNER PATTERN

Materials and Cutting			
Fabric		Yardage	Cutting
	Four favorite Dear Stella fabrics	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard each	From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 1 rectangle, 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
	Net Stella-370 White	$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Cut: Three strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x width-of-fabric (WOF) for borders. Sub-cut 2 strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", and 2 strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
	Net Stella-370 Smoke	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Cut: Four strips, 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF for binding
	Backing	1 yard or three fat quarters	
Other			
	Batting	22" x 48"	

Note: All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise specified. Press the seam allowances as indicated.

Make the Runner

1 Arrange the four rectangles in a single row, long sides together. Join the rectangles along adjacent edges. Press the seams open.

2 Join one long border strip to each long side of the joined rectangles. Press the seams open.

3 Join one short border strip to each short side of the rectangles. Press the seams open.

Finishing

1 Remove any selvages on the backing fabric. If using three fat quarters, join the fat quarters along adjacent edges and press the seams open. If using yardage, cut 1 strip, 14" x WOF, from the yardage. Sub-cut 1 rectangle, 14" x 22". Join the rectangle to the yardage along the 22" edge and press the seam open.

2 Layer the backing, batting and table runner top. Quilt as desired. Stitch around the perimeter of the runner, a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the table runner.
