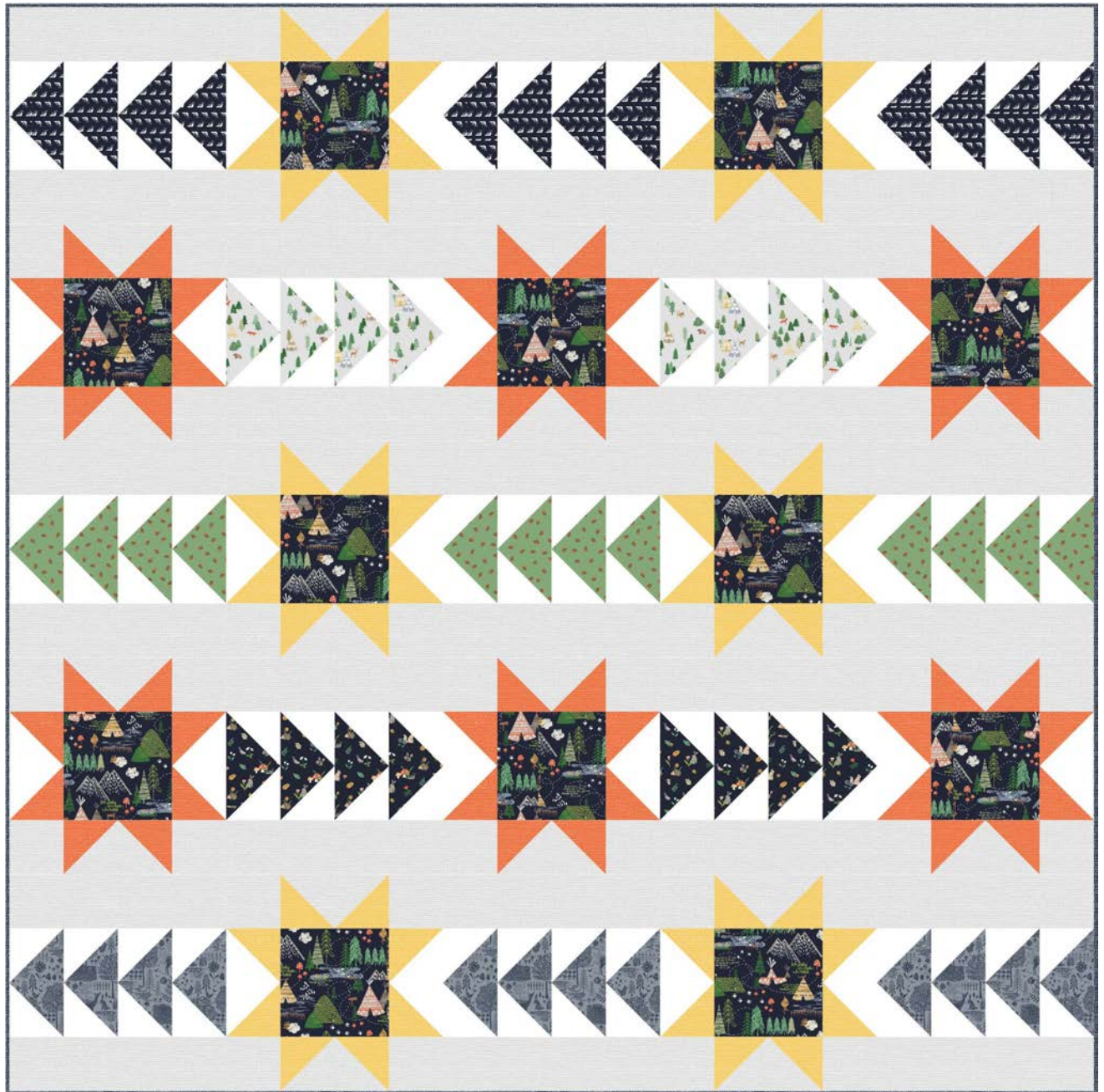

GUIDING STAR QUILT PATTERN

Materials and Cutting

Fabric		Yardage	Cutting
	Moonscape Stella-1150 Vapor	2 ⁵ / ₈ yards	Cut: 3 strips, 15 ¹ / ₂ " x width-of-fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 26 A rectangles, 4 ¹ / ₄ " x 15 ¹ / ₂ ". 6 strips, 4 ¹ / ₄ " x WOF. Sub-cut 48 B squares, 4 ¹ / ₄ " x 4 ¹ / ₄ ". 2 strips, 8 ³ / ₄ " x WOF. Sub-cut 6 squares, 8 ³ / ₄ " x 8 ³ / ₄ ". Cut each square twice diagonally to make 24 C triangles.
	Stella-Solids White	1 ¹ / ₂ yards	Cut: 7 strips, 4 ⁵ / ₈ " x WOF. Sub-cut 52 squares, 4 ⁵ / ₈ " x 4 ⁵ / ₈ ". Sub-cut each square once diagonally to make 104 F triangles. 2 strips, 8 ³ / ₄ " x WOF. Sub-cut 6 squares, 8 ³ / ₄ " x 8 ³ / ₄ ". Cut each square twice diagonally to make 24 H triangles.
	May the Forest Be With You Stella-1252 Navy	3/4 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 8" x WOF. Sub-cut 12 D squares, 8" x 8".
	Moonscape Stella-1150 Vermillion	1/2 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 4 ⁵ / ₈ " x WOF. Sub-cut 24 squares, 4 ⁵ / ₈ " x 4 ⁵ / ₈ ". Cut each square once diagonally to make 48 G triangles.
	Moonscape Stella-1150 Cyber	1/2 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 4 ⁵ / ₈ " x WOF. Sub-cut 24 squares, 4 ⁵ / ₈ " x 4 ⁵ / ₈ ". Cut each square once diagonally to make 48 I triangles.
	Snail Trail Stella-1258 Navy	1/3 yard <i>each</i>	From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 1 strip, 8 ³ / ₄ " x WOF. Sub-cut 3 squares, 8 ³ / ₄ " x 8 ³ / ₄ ". Cut each square twice diagonally to make 12 E triangles.
	Tossed Hedgehogs Stella-1257 Pine		
	Moonlit Forest Stella-1254 Slate		
	Campsite Stella-1253 Star	1/3 yard <i>each</i>	From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 1 strip, 8 ³ / ₄ " x WOF. Sub-cut 2 squares, 8 ³ / ₄ " x 8 ³ / ₄ ". Cut each square twice diagonally to make 8 E triangles.
	Woodland Creatures Stella-1255 Navy		
	Moonscape Stella-1150 Poseidon	2/3 yard	Cut: 8 strips, 2 ¹ / ₂ " x WOF, for binding.
	Mushrooms Stella-1256 Navy	5 yards	Backing

	Batting	83" x 83"	



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GUIDING STAR QUILT PATTERN

Note: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise specified. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

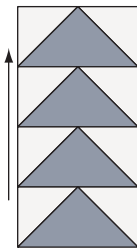
Make the Flying Geese Blocks

1 Arrange one **E** and two **F** triangles as shown. Sew the triangles together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances toward the **F** triangles. Make a total of 52 Flying Geese units.

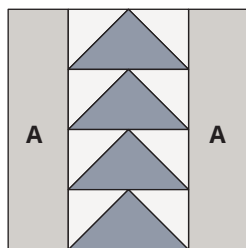


Flying Geese unit

2 Arrange four matching Flying Geese units in a single vertical row as shown. Sew the units together along adjacent edges. Press the seams toward the top Flying Geese unit.



3 Sew the long edge of one **A** rectangle to each side of the joined Flying Geese units from step 2. Press the seam allowances toward the rectangles. Make a total of 13 Flying Geese blocks.

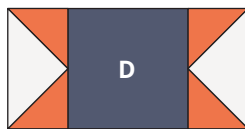
Make the Star Blocks

1 Arrange one **H** and two **G** triangles as shown. Sew the triangles together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances toward the **G** triangles. Make 12 **G/H** Flying Geese units.

2 Sew two **G/H** Flying Geese units to opposite sides of a **D** square. Press. Make 6 **D** units.



D unit

3 Arrange one **C** and two **G** triangles as shown. Sew the triangles together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances toward the **G** triangles. Make a total of 12 **G/C** Flying Geese units.

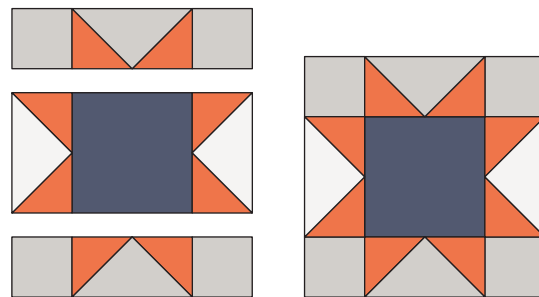


G/C Flying Geese unit

4 Sew one **B** square to each short end of the **G/C** Flying Geese units from step 3. Press.

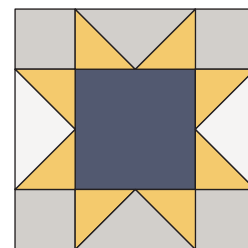


5 Arrange one **D** unit and two units from step 4 as shown. Join the units together along adjacent edges, matching seam lines. Press. Make 6 Star Blocks.

6 Repeat steps 1–5, using **I** instead of **G** triangles, to make 6 more Star Blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

1 Referring to the quilt photo for block placement and orientation, arrange the blocks in five rows of alternating Flying Geese and Star blocks. Join the blocks in each row together along adjacent edges. Press.

2 Join the rows together, matching seamlines. Press.

Finishing

1 Remove the selvages from the backing fabric, then cut the yardage into two equal lengths. Join the pieces together along one long edge, using a 1/2" seam allowance to make the quilt backing. Press.

2 Layer the quilt backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch a scant 1/4" from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.



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
