Happily ever after starts right now, because our days of waiting are over. We're writing our own story, and the fabrics in our *Save Yourself* collection set the perfect tone for our tale.



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
NOT WAITING ON MY PRINCE QUILT PATTERN

Materials and Cutting			
Fabric		Yardage	Cutting
	Stella Solid White	1 1/4 yards	Cut: 3 strips, 4 1/8" x width of fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 24 C squares, 4 1/8" x 4 1/8". 6 strips, 4 5/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 48 D squares, 4 5/8" x 4 5/8".
	Forest Frolic Stella-1321 Melba	1 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 4 1/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 24 A squares, 4 1/8" x 4 1/8". 7 strips, 2 1/2" x WOF, for binding.
	Moonscape Stella-1150 Endive	7/8 yard	Cut: 6 strips, 4 5/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 48 E squares, 4 5/8" x 4 5/8".
	Swan Pond Stella-1323 Bluejay	3/4 yard	Cut: 3 strips, 4 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut 48 B squares, 4 1/8" x 4 1/8".
	Save Yourself Stella-1317 Navy	3/4 yard <i>each</i>	From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 2 strips, 11 3/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 4 F squares, 11 3/8" x 11 3/8".
	Knight Girls Stella-1318 Navy		
	Girl Power Stella-1319 Navy		
	Unicorn Trot Stella-1320 Aqua	4 yards	Remove the selvages. Cut the yardage into two equal lengths for the backing.

	Batting	63" x 81"	


Note: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise specified.
Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

Make the Princess Blocks

1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each **D** square. Place one marked **D** square right sides together with one **E** square, aligning outer edges. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the marked line. Cut along the marked line and press the seams open. Square and trim each half-square triangle (HST) to 4 1/8" square. Make a total of 96 **D/E** HST.



2 Arrange one each **A**, **B**, and **C** square and two **D/E** HST from step 1 as shown below, making sure that HST and fabric prints are oriented correctly. Join the elements together along adjacent edges. Press. Make a total of 12 Top Rows.




Top Row
Make 12.




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3 Noting orientation of both the HST and the fabric print, join one **D/E** HST to the top and bottom of a **B** square as shown below. Press. Make 12 Left Side units.




Left Side unit

4 Repeat step 3, again noting the orientation of both the HST and the fabric print, to make 12 Right Side units.



Right Side unit
Make 12.

5 Arrange one Left Side unit and one Right Side unit on either side of a **F** square as shown. Sew the units and square together along adjacent edges. Press. Make a total of 12 Center Rows.




Center Row

6 Arrange one each **A**, **B**, and **C** square and two **D/E** HST from step 1 as shown below, making sure that HST and fabric prints are oriented correctly. Join the elements together along adjacent edges. Press. Make a total of 12 Bottom Rows.

7 Arrange one Top, one Center, and one Bottom row as shown. Sew the rows together, matching seam lines. Press. Make a total of 12 Princess Blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

1 Referring to the quilt photo for block placement, arrange the blocks in four rows of three blocks each. Sew the blocks in each row together along adjacent edges. Press the seams in alternate directions from row to row.

2 Sew the rows together along adjacent edges, matching seam lines. Press the seams in one direction.

Finishing

1 Using a 1/2" seam allowance, join the two large backing rectangles along one long edge to make the quilt backing. Press.

2 Layer the quilt backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch a scant 1/4" from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.
