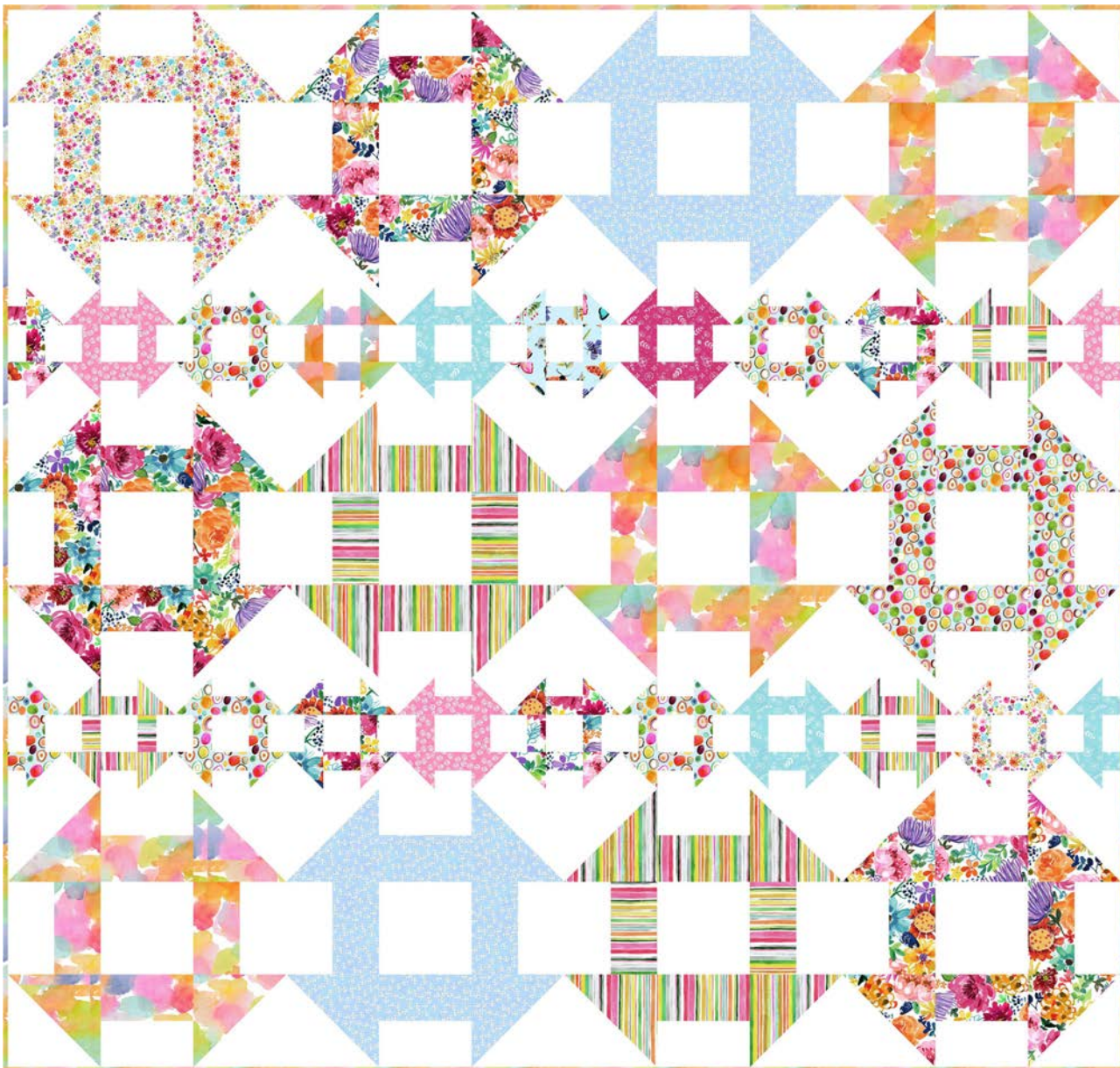

MEMORY LANE QUILT PATTERN

Materials and Cutting		
Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
 Stella Solids White	2 ³ / ₈ yards	<p>Cut:</p> <p>4 strips, 5⁷/₈" x width of fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 24 squares, 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 48 A triangles.</p> <p>6 strips, 5¹/₂" x WOF. Sub-cut 48 B rectangles, 3" x 5¹/₂", and 12 C squares, 5¹/₂" x 5¹/₂".</p> <p>3 strips, 2⁷/₈" x WOF. Sub-cut 40 squares, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 80 A1 triangles.</p> <p>5 strips, 2¹/₂" x WOF. Sub-cut 84 B1 rectangles, 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" and 18 C1 squares, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂".</p> <p>1 strip, 1¹/₂" x WOF. Sub-cut 8 D squares, 1¹/₂" x 1¹/₂".</p>
 Ephemeral Stella-DAW1096 Multi	1 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>6 strips, 2¹/₂" x WOF, for binding.</p> <p>1 strip, 5⁷/₈" x WOF. Sub-cut 6 squares, 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 12 A triangles.</p> <p>1 strip, 5¹/₂" x WOF. Sub-cut 12 B rectangles, 3" x 5¹/₂".</p> <p>From the remaining strip yardage, cut 4 B1 rectangles, 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂", and 2 squares, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 4 A1 triangles.</p>
 Spring Theory Stella-DAW1090 Multi	1/2 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>1 strip, 5⁷/₈" x WOF. Sub-cut 6 squares, 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 12 A triangles.</p> <p>1 strip, 5¹/₂" x WOF. Sub-cut twelve B rectangles, 3" x 5¹/₂".</p> <p>1 strip, 2⁷/₈" x WOF. Sub-cut 7 squares, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 14 A1 triangles.</p> <p>From the remaining yardage, cut:</p> <p>7 B1 rectangles, 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂", and 2 D squares, 1¹/₂" x 1¹/₂".</p>
 Spring Geo Stella-DAW1099 Horizon	3/8 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>1 strip, 5⁷/₈" x WOF. Sub-cut 4 squares, 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 8 A triangles.</p> <p>1 strip, 5¹/₂" x WOF. Sub-cut 8 B rectangles, 3" x 5¹/₂".</p>
 Water Stripe Stella-DAW1095 Multi	3/8 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>1 strip, 5⁷/₈" x WOF. Sub-cut 4 squares, 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 8 A triangles.</p> <p>1 strip, 5¹/₂" x WOF. Sub-cut 8 B rectangles, 3" x 5¹/₂".</p> <p>From the remaining yardage, cut:</p> <p>6 squares, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 12 A1 triangles.</p> <p>12 B1 rectangles, 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂".</p>
 Water Dots Stella-DAW1097 Aqua	3/8 yard	<p>Cut:</p> <p>1 strip, 5⁷/₈" x WOF. Sub-cut 2 squares, 5⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make four A triangles.</p> <p>1 strip, 5¹/₂" x WOF. Sub-cut 4 B rectangles, 3" x 5¹/₂".</p> <p>From the remaining strip yardage, cut:</p> <p>9 squares, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈". Cut each square once diagonally to make 18 A1 triangles.</p> <p>17 B1 rectangles, 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂".</p> <p>2 D squares, 1¹/₂" x 1¹/₂".</p>

Materials and Cutting		
Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
 Spring Fling Stella-DAW1093 White	1/4 yard	Cut: 1 strip, 5 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 2 squares, 5 7/8" x 5 7/8". Cut each square once diagonally, to make 4 A triangles. From the remaining yardage, cut: 4 B rectangles, 3" x 5 1/2". 2 squares, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8". Cut each square once diagonally to make 4 A1 triangles. 4 B1 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2".
 Spring Geo Stella-DAW1099 Begonia	1/8 yard, each	From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 5 squares, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8". Cut each square once diagonally to make 10 A1 triangles. 9 B1 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2". 2 D squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2".
 Flower Stamp Stella-DAW1098 Aquarius		
 Butterflies Stella-DAW1092 Aqua	1/8 yard, each	From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 2 squares, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8". Cut each square once diagonally to make 4 A1 triangles. 4 B1 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2".
 Flower Stamp Stella-DAW1098 Rose		
 Floral Study Stella-DAW1091 White	4 yards	Backing
Other		
Batting	68" x 65"	

Note: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise specified. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated. All pieces are sewn right sides together.

Make the Half Churn Dash Blocks

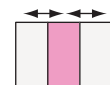
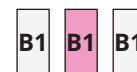
1 Refer to the quilt photo for fabric placement. For each Half Churn Dash block, select two white and two print **A1** triangles, two white and one print **B1** rectangles, and two white and two print **D** squares. Note that the print patches should match.

2 Place one white and one print **A1** triangle right sides together, matching outer edges. Sew the triangles together along the longest edge. Press the seam allowance open. Make 2 half square triangles (HST).

3 Join 1 white **B1** rectangle to each long side of the print **B1** rectangle. Press the seam allowances open.



Rectangle unit
Make 1.

4 Place one solid and one print **D** square right sides together. Join the squares along one edge. Press the seam allowance open. Make 2 **D** units.

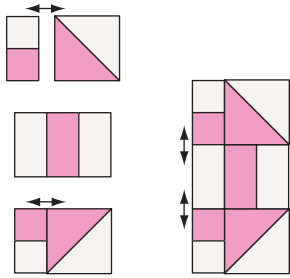

MEMORY LANE QUILT PATTERN

5 Arrange the **D** units, HST, and rectangle unit in three rows as shown. Join each **D** unit to the adjacent HST. Press the seam allowances open. Press the rows together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances open. Make a total of 4 Half Churn Dash blocks.

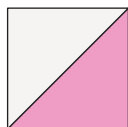
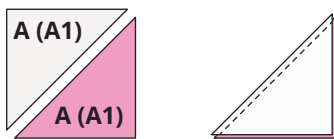


Half Churn Dash Block

Make the Churn Dash Blocks

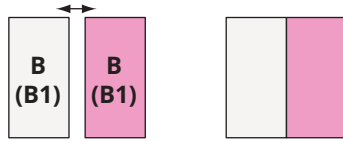
1 The large and small Churn Dash blocks are made in the same way. Patch identifiers for the small Churn Dash blocks are shown in parentheses. For each block, select four white and four print **A (A1)** triangles, four white and 4 print **B (B1)** rectangles, and one white **C (C1)** square. Note that the print patches should match.

2 Place one white and one print **A (A1)** triangle right sides together, matching outer edges. Sew the triangles together along the longest edge. Press the seam allowance open. Make 4 HST.



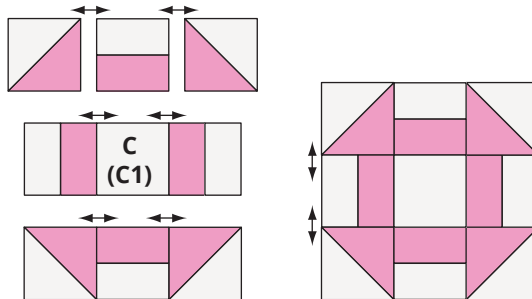
HST

3 Place one white and one print **B (B1)** rectangle right sides together. Sew the rectangles together along one long edge. Press the seam allowance open. Make 4 rectangle units.

4 Noting the orientation of the HST and rectangle units, arrange the four HST, four rectangle units, and one **C (C1)** square in three rows of three elements each as shown below. Sew the elements in each row together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances open. Sew the rows together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances open. Make a total of 12 large and 18 small Churn Dash blocks.

3 Referring to the quilt photo, place one small Churn Dash block row between two large Churn Dash block rows. Join the rows together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances in one direction.

Finishing

- 1 Remove the selvages from the backing fabric, then cut the yardage into two equal lengths. Join the pieces together along one long edge, using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Press the seam allowance open.
- 2 Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Stitch around the perimeter of the quilt, a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge. Trim the excess batting and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.

Assemble the Quilt

1 Referring to the quilt photo for block placement, arrange the large Churn Dash blocks in three rows of 4 blocks each. Join the blocks in each row along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances open.

2 Referring to the quilt photo for block placement and orientation, arrange the small Churn Dash blocks and Half Churn Dash blocks in two rows of 9 blocks and two half blocks each. Join the blocks and half blocks along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances open.
